- 2. Is the progress of disadvantaged children, disabled children or children with SEND close to or improving towards that of other pupils with the same starting points? *Groups: Pupil premium, SEND, Gender, EAL, BME Comparison to non-identified group.*
- 3. Is children's progress above average or improving across a wide range of subjects?
- 4. Do children read widely and often?

Records of reading – who is reading and not? If not, what is being done to address this? Set target for next PPM. Reading widely: evidenced through Core stories, GR planning, books available in book corners and reading records

- 5. Where is overall attainment? If low, does it show consistent improvement?
- **6.** What % at ARE? How does this compare to similar / local schools? If low, does it show consistent improvement?
