- Incredible toddler: 12 weeks - enrol when baby is 10 months+

IF YOU ARE WORRIED ABOUT A CHILD'S SPEECH AND LANGUAGE:

Health Visitors and GPs:

- If a baby has a low score (but a grey area) for speech and language development in 8 to 12 month assessment, complete Part 1 of the Early Help form to request support for the family. This could include support in speech and language from a family centre
- Refer children to Speech and Language Therapy service (SALT) in the usual way

Early Years Professionals:

- Refer children to the SALT in the usual way
- If you think the family would benefit from other support, including how to encourage their child's development more generally, complete Part 1 of the Early Help form and send to sheffieldfamilycentres@sheffield.gov.uk - a plan of support will be agreed

Parents and carers: Contact your:

- Local family centre
- Health Visitor
- Speech and Language family advice line- telephone advice due to Covid-19 measures. Regular drop-in sessions are usually held at family centres

Talking Toddlers - run by Speech and Language Therapy Service (by referral only)

- 12 week programme
- Run by Speech and Language therapists

Child must be two during programme - refer from about 21 months.

Referral to the Speech and Language Therapy Service

- Your child will have a 30 minute appointment to assess if/what support will be given
- Support could be at a group, at nursery or 1-2-1 sessions depending on their needs

Free "Play and Say Training" for: Childminders & Early Years Providers, delivered in settings and in Family Centres.
